




Itinerary Summary - Russia

Days 1-5 "BEHIND THE IRON CURTAIN IN MOSCOW"

- Venture behind the iron curtain in Moscow as we explore the essence of cold war Russia
- Go underground to learn the workings of the once infamous KGB organisation
- ◆ Spend a day in training with the Russian Army. You could be shooting AK47s, throwing hand grenades or riding a Russian tanksome will even get to be in the drivers seat of the tank!!
- Experience the life of a Russian Cosmonaut during a visit to a (once top secret) space training centre- even try the space food!
- Delve deeper past Moscow's modern façade with guided tours of Red Square, St Basils and the Kremlin which is now the residence of Vladamir Putin as well as a museum housing a unique display of Faberge's famous jewelled eggs
- *OPTIONS enjoy free time to indulge your own interests. You may wish to visit magnificent Cathedrals, Art Galleries and Museums, do a backstage tour of the Bolshoi theatre or even take in a show, rent a bike in Gorky Park or visit the late night entertainment districts (once the domain of the underground mafia)

Days 5 - 9 "THE TSARS IMPERIAL RUSSIA IN ST PETERSBURG"

- Nicknamed the "Venice of the North" for its extensive network of canals, in St Petersburg you will discover a city rich in culture and revolutionary spirit...Russias imperial capital never ceases to amaze
- Enjoy a guided canal boat tour exploring everyday city life while seeing the curiosities and magnificent architecture of the city
- Visit Catherine Palace, one of Russias grandest Royal Estates with its main attraction -the extraordinary "Amber Room"
- Tour the site of the Mad Monk Rasputin's Death and learn of the last days of the Russian Royal family at the Yusopov Palace Gala Dinner
- Explore the Peter and Paul Fortress as we learn about the heroes of the Russian revolution
- ◆ *OPTIONS use your free time to shop on Nevsky Provence, visit the faberge museum, explore the bar and nightlife scene, enjoy the opera at Marinsky Theatre, participate in a culinary cooking class of Russian classics or take the hydrofoil to view the gardens of Peterhof palace –known as the Russian Versailles





Itinerary Summary – Norway

Days 9 - 13 "IN SEARCH OF THE NORTHERN LIGHTS ABOVE THE ARCTIC CIRCLE"

- Tromsø's location 400km North of the arctic circle places us in one
 of Norway's famed spots for viewing the northern Lights but
 Tromsø is also a notoriously lively city with an international vibe.
 With more pubs per capita than anywhere else in Norway you can
 be guaranteed a good night out!
- Go Aurora hunting to unique safari bonfire sites and if clear skies prevail and mother nature is kind we may see a northern lights show.
- Ride the cable car high above Tromsø during a city orientation tour
- Visit Bivrost Distillery –the most northern in the world -to taste the locally made spirits while hearing of Nordic/viking mythology
- Meet with the local Sami people, indigenous to the Arctic Lapland region and are dependant on their huskies and reindeer to exist in the harsh arctic climate
- Enjoy free time in the natural environs around Tromsø to go hiking or kayaking, take fjord wildlife tours, ride an ATV buggy or visit nearby islands via rib boat, taste the local seafood at the markets or even go arctic fishing to catch your own.
